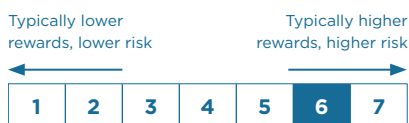

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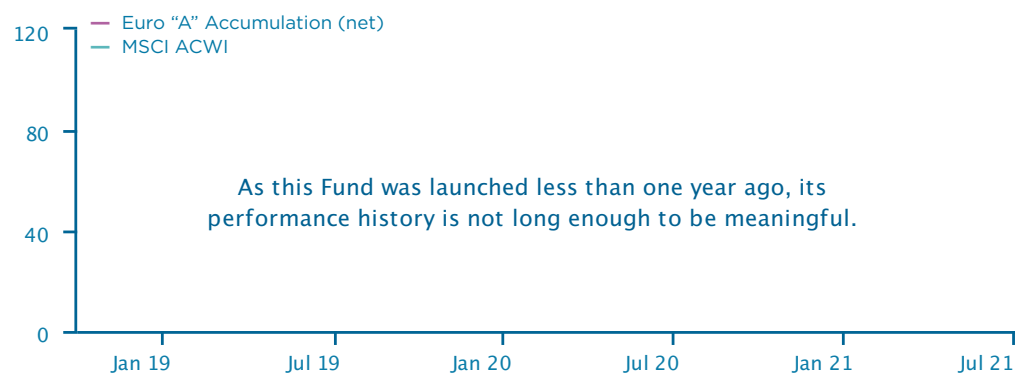

Fund specific risks

Market risk: The Fund's investments are subject to market fluctuations, so they can fall as well as rise in value.
